1 Apologies

Apologies for absence were received from Councillors J Chaplow, A Reed and P Sexton.

2 Substitute Members

3 Minutes

The minutes of the meeting held on 14 February 2024 were agreed as a correct record and signed by the Chair.

5 Exclusion of the public

6 Consideration of an Application to be licensed as a Private Hire Driver
