Purpose of the Report

To consider a request for temporary traffic regulation by Order from 7am on Saturday 18 May 2024 for the purpose of preventing obstruction of the highway during the Sedgefield Mediaeval Fayre event and procession on roads adjacent to The Square, Rectory Row and Burton Mews, Sedgefield.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Council exercises its powers under the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 to effect a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order to facilitate the proposed event

Background

A community event is proposed to be held within the confines of the highway which is likely to result in thronging of the highway.

Options

Other traffic management arrangements have been considered and the most appropriate method is for temporary phased road closures for up to 9 hours.

Recommendation

The recommendation is approved and that following, consultations with the Chief of Police, arrangements be made to progress sealing of an Order.

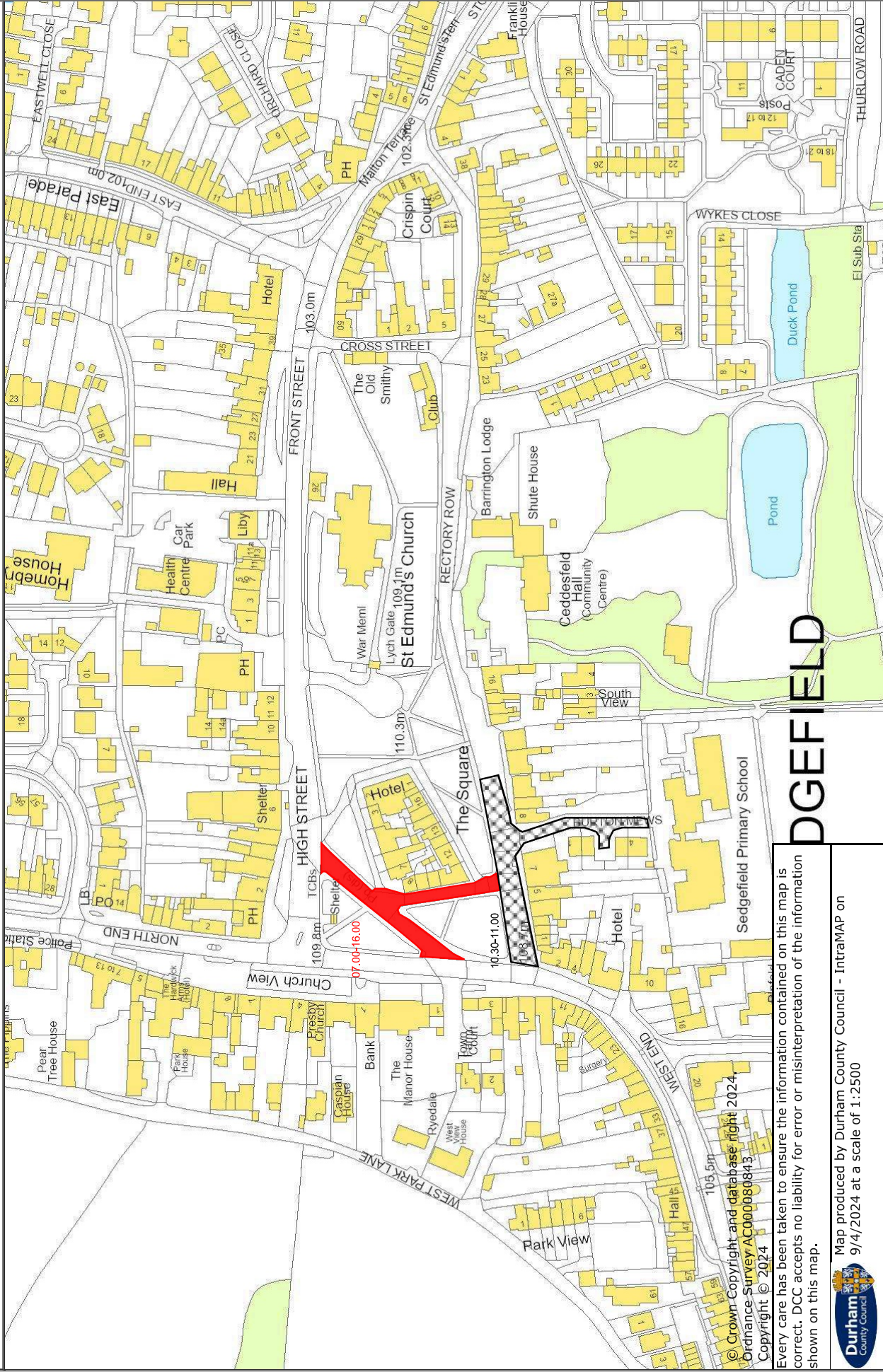
