CICC members reviewed DCC's Children Looked After Strategic Partnership's (CLASP) priorities and presented them to CPP in January.

At the last older CICC meeting, members graded them in order of what was important to them, which was 1 ,2 and 3.

The ask of CPP is that a meeting can be arranged to discuss the following theme like previous CICC / CPP joint meetings:-

#1 Emotional and Physical Wellbeing - It was felt that emotional and physical support tailored and provided by the right people at the right time.

#2 Feeling Safe - A stable home that creates positive memories and promotes good times growing up was seen as important.

Two themes were joint third:

#3 Positive People in Your Life – Having people around you that are positive and who you can turn to for advice/support/friendship was significant – Everyone needs a Friend! Alongside being part of the local community in different ways.

#3 Being Listened to – Having the chance to share your view on life in different ways was seen as important.
