The applicant has proposed steps, which they intend to be taken in order to promote the four licensing objectives. These are outlined under Part P of the application form.

The application has been advertised on the premises and in the local press as prescribed.

Background Information

On 14th January 2011, the Licensing Authority received an application and supporting Certificate under Section 53 of the Licensing Act 2003 from Durham Constabulary where it was required to consider the matter within 48 hours of receipt of this application.

Section 53A provides that the Chief Officer of Police may apply for an urgent review of a premises where there is the sale of alcohol and where it is considered the premises are associated with serious crime or disorder.

On 18th January 2011, the Licensing Statutory Sub Committee met to consider the application where it was decided to suspend the premises licence with immediate effect.

On 1st February 2011, the Licensing Statutory Sub Committee met to consider the representation and decided to continue with the suspension of the premises licence until the full review hearing on 10th February 2011.

On 10th February 2011, the Licensing Statutory Committee decided to revoke the premises licence and for the suspension imposed at the previous interim hearing to continue but only until such time as the revocation came into effect.

As no appeal was made to the Magistrates' Court by the applicant the revocation came into effect on 9 March 2011.

26th April 2011

A new premises licence application for The Stanefordham in the name of Dawn Amanda Davey (Applicant) was considered by the Licensing Statutory Committee. Members decision was to refuse to grant the premises licence.

22nd June 2011

A new premises licence application for The Stanefordham in the name of Pauline Munro (Applicant) was received by the Licensing Authority. A notice to extend the time limit to determine the application was issued to all parties as it was agreed to consider the application by the end of November 2011 as separate criminal proceedings which would have a bearing on the hearing of the application would not have concluded until 14th November 2011.

On 9th November 2011, the Licensing Authority received correspondence from Pauline Munro stating she wished to withdraw the application for the grant of a premises licence in relation to the Stanefordham.

3. The Representations

The Licensing Authority received one representation in relation to the premises licence application, from Durham Constabulary (Responsible Authority), see attached Appendix 4.

The representation undermines one of the licensing objectives, namely, the prevention of crime and disorder. The Licensing Authority deemed the representation to be relevant.

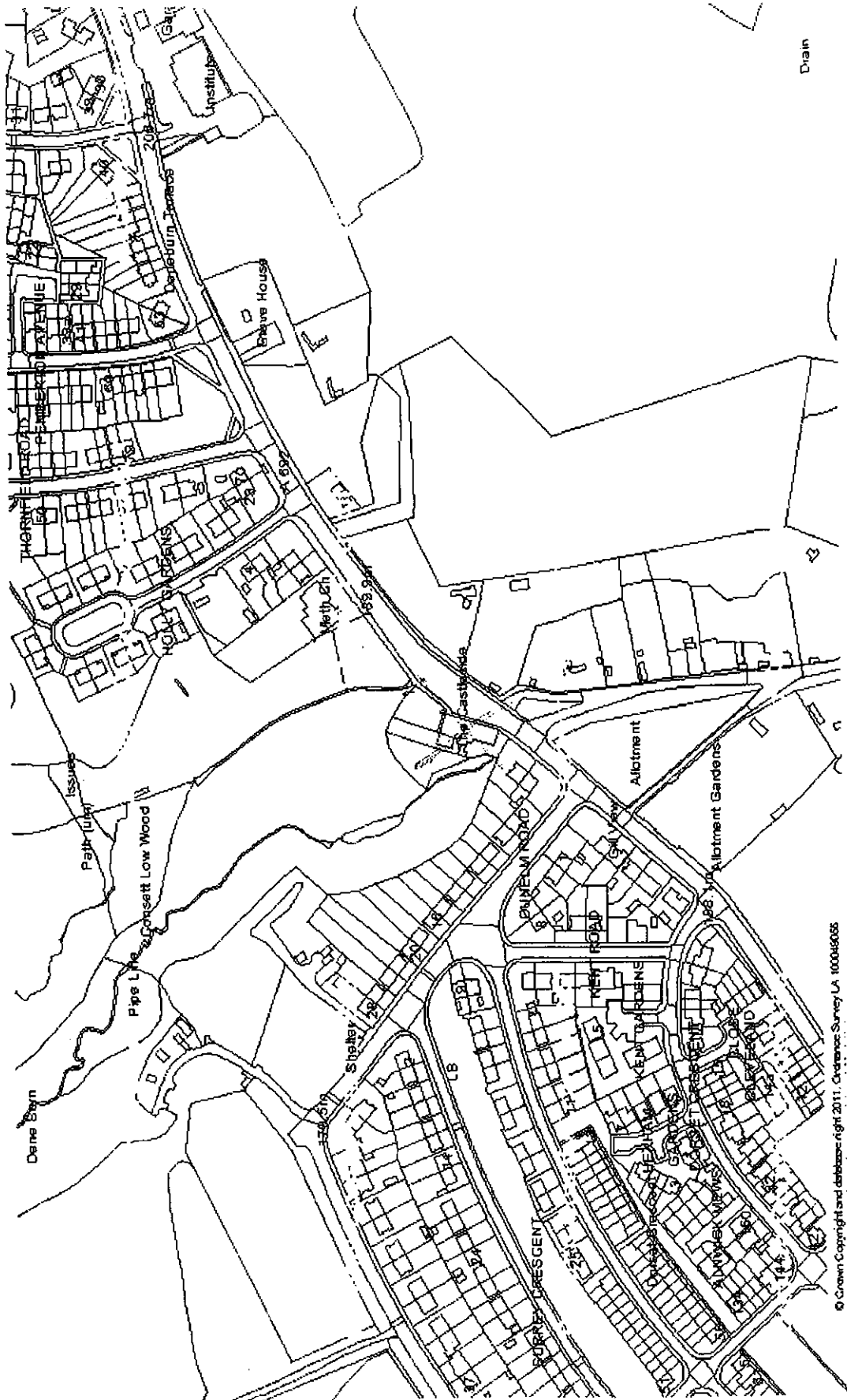

Location Plan




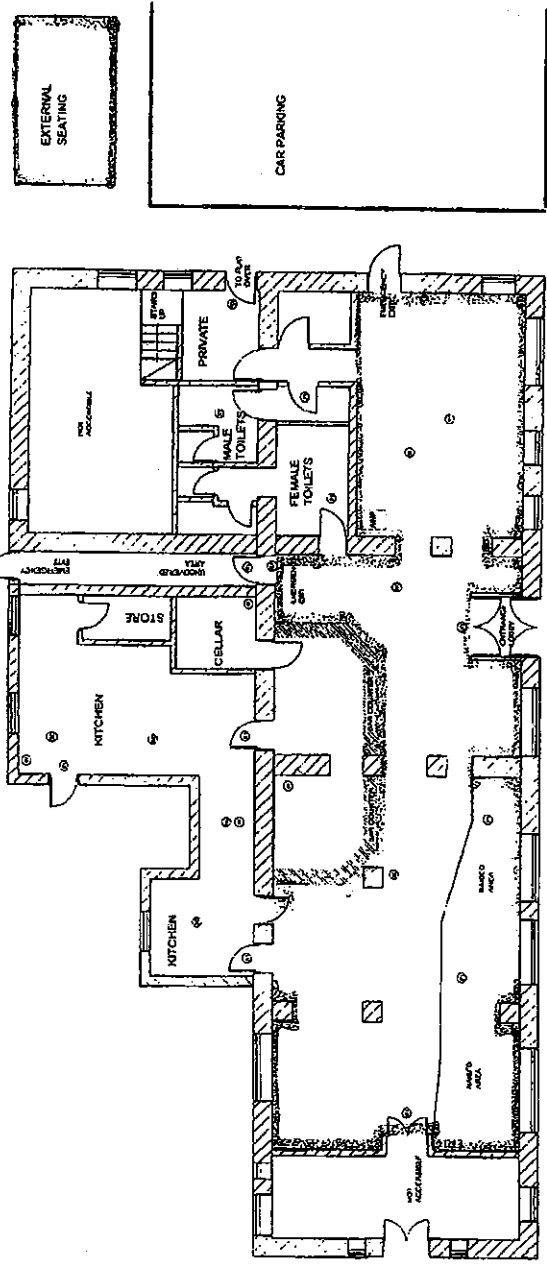

Plan Showing the Layout of the Premises

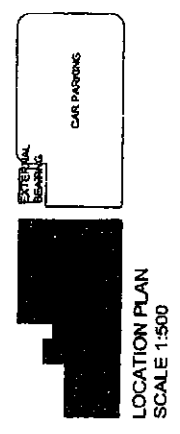




