## 39. <u>NEIGHBOURHOOD RENEWAL</u>

Stephen Davison the Neighbourhood Renewal Research & Monitoring Officer presented report C and gave a presentation which informed the panel of the current situation regarding Neighbourhood Renewal Funding (NRF) within Derwentside.

In 2001 the Governments National Strategy Action Plan 'A New Commitment to Neighbourhood Renewal' was launched as part of the Action Plan, additional resources were made available to the 88 most deprived areas based upon the Index of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) The 2004 IMD placed Derwentside as the 67<sup>th</sup> most deprived local authority in England. The Local Strategic Partnership must manage the NRF performance against the National Floor Targets, details as below:-

Derwentside has been allocated 12 million pounds since 2001 The funding was split into 7 thematic groups based upon performance against the indicators in 2005:-

- Employment
- Education
- Health
- Housing & Environment

- Economic Development
- Supporting Communities
