1. Introduction

1.1 The purpose of this report is to provide Members with an update on the progress made by the Derwentside Employment Team in tackling worklessness in Derwentside.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Derwentside Partnership has allocated over £1.5m of NRF resources during 2006/08 to support a local response to worklessness that can work alongside national Job Centre Plus initiatives such as Pathways To Work.
- 2.2 The Council took the lead in establishing the Derwentside Employment Team which became operational in October 2006 with seconded staff from Job Centre Plus, Durham PCT and Durham County Council.

3.2 The Team has made strong progress in a short period of time and has established an extensive network of community outlets across the District. The Team remains focussed on getting people into work and on the long term IB claimants in the District. It should be noted that of the 28 IB claimants going into work some 70% had been on IB for over one year.

4.0 Conclusion

4.1 Tackling worklessness is a complex issue that needs a long-term, co-ordinated response from a range of local and national agencies. The Derwentside Employment Team has funding to operate until the end of March 2008. The Team is currently preparing the operational plan for 2007/08. The performance of the Team will continued to be monitored and evaluated with a view to securing longer term funding.
