4. Urgent Decision of the Executive Renewal of the Contract for the Kerbside Collection of Materials for Recycling

The Chief Executive reports that the Executive at its meeting on 27 November 2007 considered that the decision taken in respect of the abovementioned report was urgent and should not be subject to the call-in process.
