3. TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 SECTION 257 – BRIDLEWAY STOPPING UP ORDER AND DIVERSION
THE DISTRICT OF EASINGTON (FORMER HAWTHORN COLLIERY, MURTON)
BRIDLEWAY NO. 29 STOPPING UP AND DIVERSION ORDER

The Monitoring Officer reported that in order to enable industrial development to proceed on the Hawthorn Cokeworks site it was necessary to stop up and divert Murton Bridleway No. 29.

Therefore, the Council was requested to make an Order under Section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990. A copy of the Order and Order map was attached to the Agenda which showed the bridleway to be stopped up and diverted. The Monitoring Officer pointed out an amendment to the wording of the Order, stating that Part 1 of the Schedule should read as follows:-

'The whole width of the bridleway from point A to point B for a length of 660 metres as shown with a solid black line on the Order map.'

RESOLVED that subject to the amendment to the wording in Part 1 of the Schedule to the Order, as outlined, the District Council hereby make the District of Easington (Former Hawthorn Colliery, Murton) Bridleway No. 29 Stopping Up and Diversion Order;

FURTHER RESOLVED that authority be granted for the necessary statutory order procedures to be carried out.
