- 4. Durham Aged Mineworkers Homes Association is hereby required to pay for the cost of making this order.

Where immediately before the date on which the footpath are stopped up there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along and across them belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.
