As Members will be aware, Sedgefield Borough has been twinned with Rheinhausen since 1990 and throughout the last ten years of that period Rheinhausen Council has been chaired by Gűnter Heiser.

Herr Heiser has proved to be a good friend of the Borough Council over the years and has been very supportive of the twinning links that have been developed between the people of Rheinhausen and Sedgefield.

He has now written to the Council indicating that it is his intention to step down from his position as Chairman and retire from political life.
