# Report of Head of Overview and Scrutiny

### **Purpose of Report**

1. To make progress about Co-options to the Sub-Committee.

## **Background**

- 2. The Constitution provides the opportunity for six non-voting co-opted representatives to be involved in the work of the Sub-Committee. The Overview and Scrutiny Committee is generally charged with the responsibility of seeking to involve the community in its work. The co-option of representatives from the wider community and the development of a dialogue with them should assist in this approach.
- 3. The Overview and Scrutiny Committee, in July, agreed to approach six organisations to serve on the main Overview and Scrutiny Committee. Those organisations are:-
  - The Durham Association of Parish and Town Councils
  - Voluntary Sector One Voice
  - TUC
  - North East Chamber of Commerce
  - Strategic Health Authority
  - County Durham Association of Local Authorities
- 4. The Sub-Committee now needs to consider the bodies it wishes to approach to provide co-opted members. The role of a co-opted member, whilst non-voting, would provide an opportunity to influence the Sub-Committee in its work. A co-opted member would not simply attend Sub-Committee meetings. The aim is to engage in dialogue with co-opted members to seek their views about relevant issues.
- 5. In addition, observers from political parties and representatives on the Council have been invited to attend meetings of the Sub-Committee.
- 6. The task of selecting appropriate co-opted members is not an easy one. The breadth of this Sub-Committee is very wide and there are a large number or organisations that could be approached. In particular, the aim will be to provide added value to the work of the Sub-Committee by co-opting a representative. Northumbria University have offered to assist in the search for appropriate co-optees. It is suggested that the Chairman and Vice Chairmen of the Sub-Committee and the Main Committee should be given delegated authority to make suggestions about the bodies to be approached.

# Recommendation

7. That the Chairmen and Vice Chairmen should be given delegated authority to suggest a list of co-opted members.
