It was proposed to amend the layout of this section of the site so that two units were constructed rather than three units as formerly approved.

Access to the development was proposed via an existing access point off Long Tens Way. A total of 64 car parking spaces, 20 loading bays for heavy goods vehicles and 12 cycle spaces would be provided on site.

A Design and Access Statement had been submitted in support of the application together with supporting information including an Economic Statement and an extended Phase 1 survey update.
