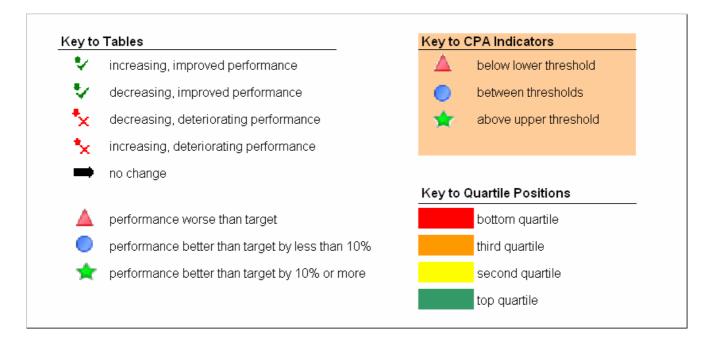
Economy Scrutiny Sub-Committee 10 September 2007 Q1 2007/08 Performance



Report of the Head of Economic Development and Regeneration

- 1. The purpose of this report is to provide an update of quarter 1 performance for the authority's priorities relevant to our Corporate Aim, Build a Strong Economy.
- 2. To gain maximum impact of performance management intelligence from Performance Plus, the Authority's performance management system, tolerances and milestones have been set for 2007/08 targets.

Areas of concern,

(Indicators not achieving quarter 1 target with deteriorating performance since 06/07year-end)

- The number of incapacity benefit claimants in the County has reduced slightly from the last quarter of 2006/07 and is now back at the baseline position. However, the 2007/08 target for this indicator is 33,300, i.e. 2,800 lower than the figure achieved. The nature of the activity required to improve this indicator means that any improvement is hoped to be reflected in the 2008/09 figures.
