<b>MILESTONES AND DELIVERABLES ACHIEVED THIS PERIOD:</b>	
<p><b>The Wear and Tees Community Safety Partnership is a statutory group. They also act as the theme group for Community Safety for Teesdale Partnership and Wear Valley LSP.</b></p> <p><b>The group have met several times since the last Executive Committee to produce and edit their Partnership Strategic Assessment.</b></p> <p><b>This Assessment is now complete and priorities have been agreed and approved. These are, wounding, domestic abuse, criminal damage, anti-social behaviour and reducing offending.</b></p> <p><b>Crime reduction projection of 13% by the end of the year compared with the 12.5% agreed with the Home Office.</b></p> <p><b>Wounding, vehicle interference and theft from pedal cycle showing an increase.</b></p> <p><b>£5,000 funding agreed for target hardening at Winston to reduce problems with travellers. Further funding also made available to a number of clubs, which divert young people away from crime.</b></p>

<p><b>It is agreed to proceed with a radio advertising campaign to publicise the services available to the public and to encourage public participation.</b></p> <p><b>A full plan of action to be drafted to address the priority crime areas.</b></p>
