The Wear and Tees Community Safety Partnership is a statutory group. They also act as the theme group for Community Safety for Teesdale Partnership and Wear Valley LSP.	
The group have met several times since the last Executive Committee to produce and edit their Partnership Strategic Assessment. This Assessment is now complete and priorities have been agreed and approved. The priority areas are, wounding, domestic abuse, criminal damage, anti-social behaviour and reducing offending.
