MILESTONES AND DELIVERABLES ACHIEVED THIS PERIOD:

The second Sustainable Community Strategy for Teesdale 2021: Working Together for Teesdale was launched at the Partnership AGM Wednesday 30th April, 2008. The challenge now for all of the theme groups is the delivery of their action plans to achieve the strategic outcomes identified in the strategy.

The Environment and Transport Group met 28th May, 2008: Sue Mullinger of Durham County Council presented the Draft South West Durham Heritage Corridor Management Plan 2008 – 2018. She was seeking the endorsement of the plan by the group and wished to list the Environment Group, which represents both Teesdale and Wear Valley LSP's as a partner on the back cover of the plan. They are hoping to employ a project manager to identify potential early projects and set future priorities and are seeking funding from the Heritage Lottery fund. The main project of the plan is the utilization of the disused railway between Barnard Castle and West Auckland as a green cycle route.

It was agreed that Teesdale LSP would circulate the plan to the Parish Councils with a request for feedback to Sue Mullinger at the Parish Forum 21st July, 2008, however since that meeting Durham County Council have decided to hold a special collective meeting for the parishes affected (and interested parties) to debate the plan etc. since this is likely to offer greater opportunity for a productive discussion around what these communities consider the priorities to be. – Contact Steve Bhowmick
