<b>MILESTONES AND DELIVERABLES ACHIEVED THIS PERIOD:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Teesdale a safer place to live, work, invest and play: Proactive policing and partnership working and neighbourhood problems identified. Tasking and coordinating has identified a number of hotspot areas such as Cockfield. BCU funding agreed, awaiting Police Authority decision in September for the remaining £5,000</li><li>• Community safety plan approved by CDRP: Delivery plans completed and being monitored by SDMSG.</li><li>• Domestic abuse: A radio campaign and bus liner campaign ran in June July to advertise the support service. A dedicated domestic abuse unit has been established at Bishop Auckland Police Station with one sergeant and four officers. Previously only one officer.</li><li>• Road traffic accidents: Provided a motor bike safety motorbike pocket maps.</li><li>• Review of ASB panel, ASB process and ASBO protocol. Also review of Management Support Unit and Tasking and Coordinating Unit: More cohesive working with escalation protocols established and being used.</li></ul>	
<b>MILESTONES AND DELIVERABLES TO BE ACHIEVED NEXT PERIOD:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Teesdale a safer place to live, work, invest and play: Hope this is resolved by end of September. Looking at target hardening Co-op. Banning orders used and seeking funding for youth shelter.</li><li>• Community safety plan approved by CDRP: Some timescales and progress still required for other agencies</li><li>• Domestic abuse: Police data to be broken down to district level. Need to look at how this service will be delivered in 2009 when there is one unitary. Currently Wear and Tees the best resourced but this could change if this becomes a commissioned service.</li><li>• Road traffic accidents: Consideration of funding to repeat this next year.</li></ul>
