We have been retired now for eight years and have no access to a computer or wifi and we are not computer orientated therefore we are not able to take part in the meeting.

I would like to point out to the members of the hearing that these premises are located mid terraced in a residential area with young families with children, pensioners and a home that has special needs adults residing. As you will have seen by the photos supplied cars parked on footpaths and down each side of the road this could be a safety issue with devastating consequences. If the hours are extended this would obviously increase the traffic and increase the risks.

People are regularly on their phones smoking and discarding cigarette ends this is not minor it carries a fine and is against the law.

We also believe that with the proximity and the extended hours there is every chance that young people passing on their way home have a possibility of causing anti social behaviour.

You may say well you bought a house near a public house but at the time the licensing hours were very different 10 pm closing on a evening and Sunday afternoon 12.00 till 2.00 not as is proposed 9.00 in the morning till 12.30 the following morning 7 days a week. People will be exiting the premises near to 1 O' Clock in the morning and with being under the influence of drink voices will be raised as they wish each other goodnight.
