Mr Ravichandran has also addressed the actions contained and within the Fire Risk Assessment. I have revisited this property on the 11th October 2023 to check the work has been undertaken after Mr Ravichandran contacted me to tell me he had completed all the work required

I am happy to say I would be satisfied to say that 122 Cockton Hill Store is compliant with the Fire Safety Order due to the measures he has put in place.

I found only two minor items needing to be addressed and these were: - FIRE ACTION NOTICES required and a broken electrical socket to be repaired near to the entrance door. Mr Ravichandran gave me an assurance he would address these that day.
