Recent prosecutions

- FPN ISSUED FOR FLY TIPPING.
- A 53-year-old male from the Spennymoor area, has been issued with a Fixed Penalty Notice in relation to a Fly Tipping offence on the c152 leading to Vyners Close outside of Spennymoor.
- The offence was captured on CCTV, following an investigation carried out by a Member of the Wardens Fly Tipping Investigation Team. The male was interviewed and accepted responsibility for the offence.
- The Fixed Penalty Notice set at £400, needs to be paid within 14 days or the male will be prosecuted for the offence.

A NIGHT IN A POLICE CELL FOR FLY TIPPING


A former Coundon resident was issued a Fixed Penalty Notice for fly tipping back in 2021 which he failed to pay and didn't appear at court. Wilson had tipped waste from his yard into the back street after a warden had spoken to him about disposing of it correctly. An arrest warrant was issued, and cops caught up with him and he was arrested in York and spent the night and most of the next day in a cell before being brought before magistrates. He pleaded guilty to the offence and was handed a 6month conditional discharge and costs of £356.


