2 Substitute Members

3 Declarations of interest, if any

4 Minutes

6 Application for the Ongoing Suitability of a Hackney Carriage Driver

The Chairman welcomed the Licence Holder and his representative to the meeting and introductions took place.

The Sub-Committee considered a report of the Corporate Director of Adult Services to determine the ongoing suitability of a Hackney Carriage Driver (for copy, see file of minutes).

Members and Officers were given the opportunity to ask questions following both presentations.
