Purpose of the Report

An amendment is required to the Newton Aycliffe Traffic Regulation Order to manage and control parking within Newton Aycliffe.

Executive summary

Millennium Way, Long Tens Way and Moordale Road – To introduce ‘no waiting at any time’ parking restrictions to address parking and ongoing road safety issues.

Recommendation

Progress to advert.

Background

Millennium Way, Long Tens Way and Moordale Road:

Hitachi Rail Europe LTD is situated at the west end of Millennium Way. A request was received from the business to address parking and ongoing road safety issues.

It is proposed that a ‘no waiting at any time’ restriction to be introduced on both sides of Millennium Way from its junction with Long Tens Way in a westerly direction towards Hitachi Rail Europe LTD.

The response to the initial consultation was that all reply’s from directly affected frontages were in favour of the new proposals.

The proposals were Formally Advertised from 14th December 2018 – 7th January 2019 as part of a wider TRO in Newton Aycliffe.

Further to this a request was received by Lidl Ltd situated south of Moordale Road, Newton Aycliffe to extend the 'no waiting at any time' proposed restrictions on the junction of Moordale Road and extend the restrictions to the east on Millennium Way.

Statutory Consultees have been consulted and are in favour of the amendments.
