### **Purpose of the Report**

To consider a request for temporary traffic regulation by Order on 01/05/19 for the purpose of Surface Dressing works throughout County Durham.

### **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the Council exercises its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to effect a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order to facilitate the proposed works.

### **Background**

A programme of Surface Dressing has been agreed to undertake resurfacing works within the confines of the highway in various locations throughout the county.

### **Options**

Other traffic management arrangements have been considered and the most appropriate method is for a blanket order covering the works which are short term (typically one day or less) per location over a period of around 4 months.

### **Recommendation**

The recommendation is approved and that following, consultations with the Chief of Police, arrangements be made to progress the advertising of Public Notices and sealing of an Order.
