Purpose of the Report

- Tolent contacted the Council to request a licence for 3 No. tower cranes, at the above location, which is to be used during their development of the site. (As shown on the attached plan).
- 3 The cranes are likely to over sail the highway during their operation, therefore they will require a section 178 licence.
- Tolent have supplied the required information, in regard to public liability insurance, which will at all times indemnify the County Council and all persons who are at any time present on the adjoining highway.
