Purpose of the Report

To consider a request for temporary traffic regulation by Order on **Sunday 21 July 2019** for the purpose of preventing obstruction of the highway and to safeguard members of the public accessing the **Bikewise** event in Durham.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Council exercises its powers under the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 to effect a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order to facilitate the proposed event

Background

Durham Constabulary propose to undertake the annual Bikewise event on Sunday 21/07/19 which will require a temporary road closure order (between 6am and 6pm) to prevent obstruction of the highway when it is liable to be thronged.

Options

Other traffic management arrangements have been considered and the most appropriate method is for temporary road closure.

Recommendation

The recommendation is approved and that following, consultations with the Chief of Police, arrangements be made to progress the advertising of Public Notices and sealing of an Order.
