Works are proposed to be undertaken within the confines of the highway by Tolent Construction in association with redevelopment of the former Passport Office (National Savings) site.

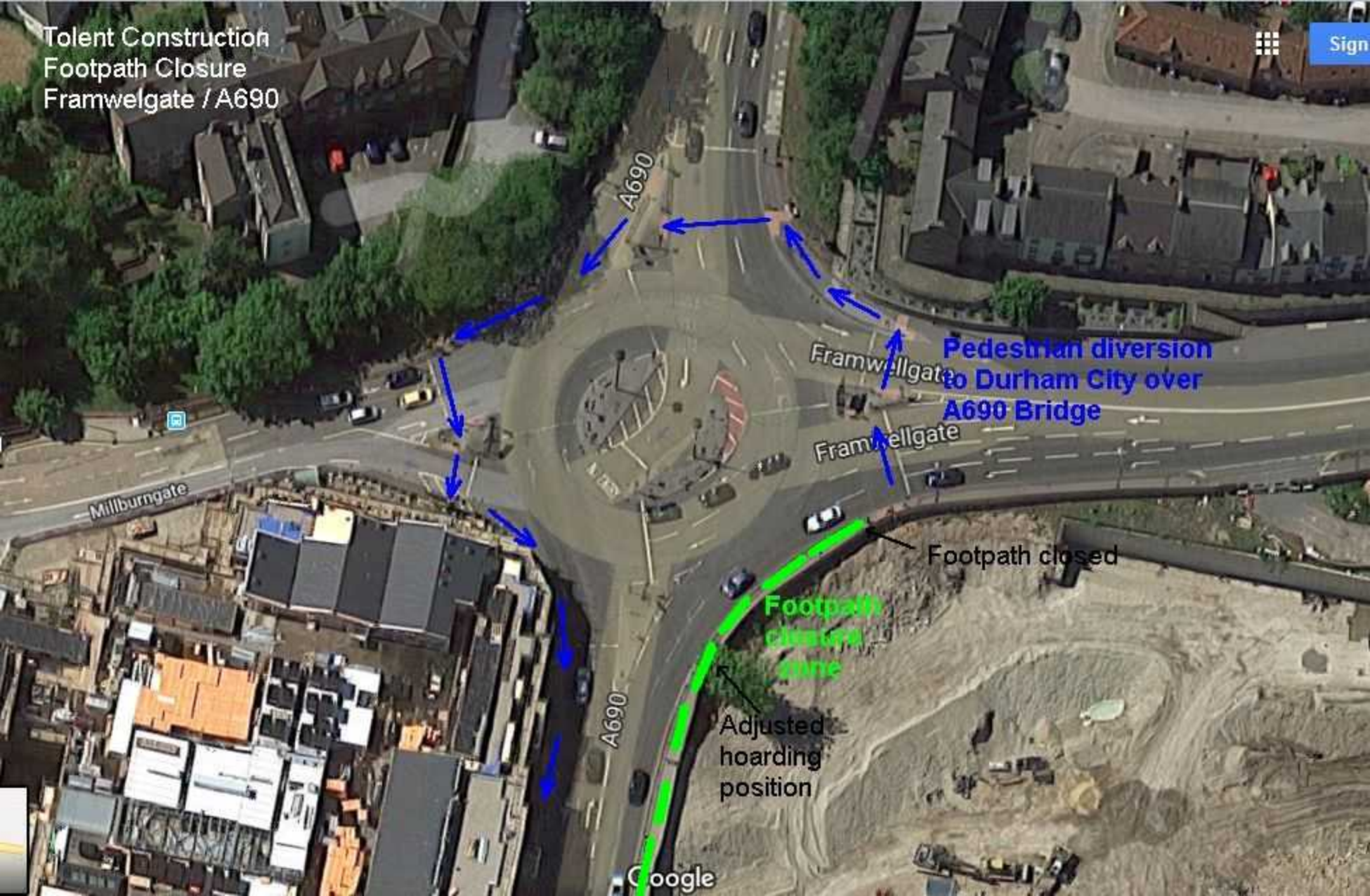

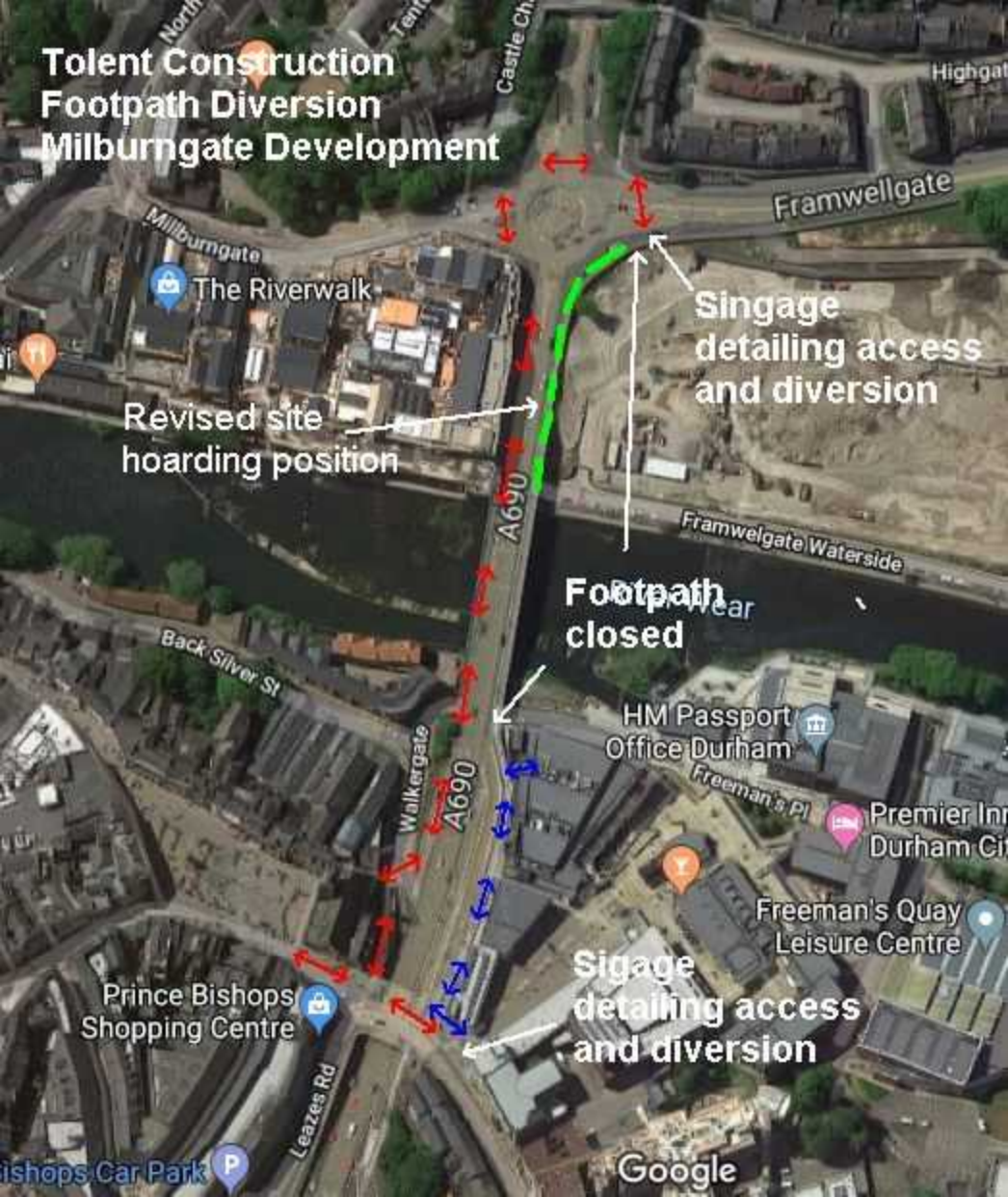
