Purpose of the Report

To consider a request for temporary traffic regulation by Order on Thursday 25 and Friday 26 July 2019 for the purpose of enabling the Durham City Run Festival events to take place safely.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Council exercises its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to effect a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order to facilitate the proposed event.

Background

The Durham City Run Festival event is proposed to be undertaken within the confines of the highway on Thursday 25 July (5k & 10 k run) and Friday 26 July 2019 (1 mile - Run Like a Legend).

Options

Other traffic management arrangements have been considered and the most appropriate method is for temporary traffic regulation – full road closures both with and without convoy vehicle access

Recommendation

The recommendation is approved and that following, consultations with the Chief of Police, arrangements be made to progress the advertising of Public Notices and sealing of an Order.

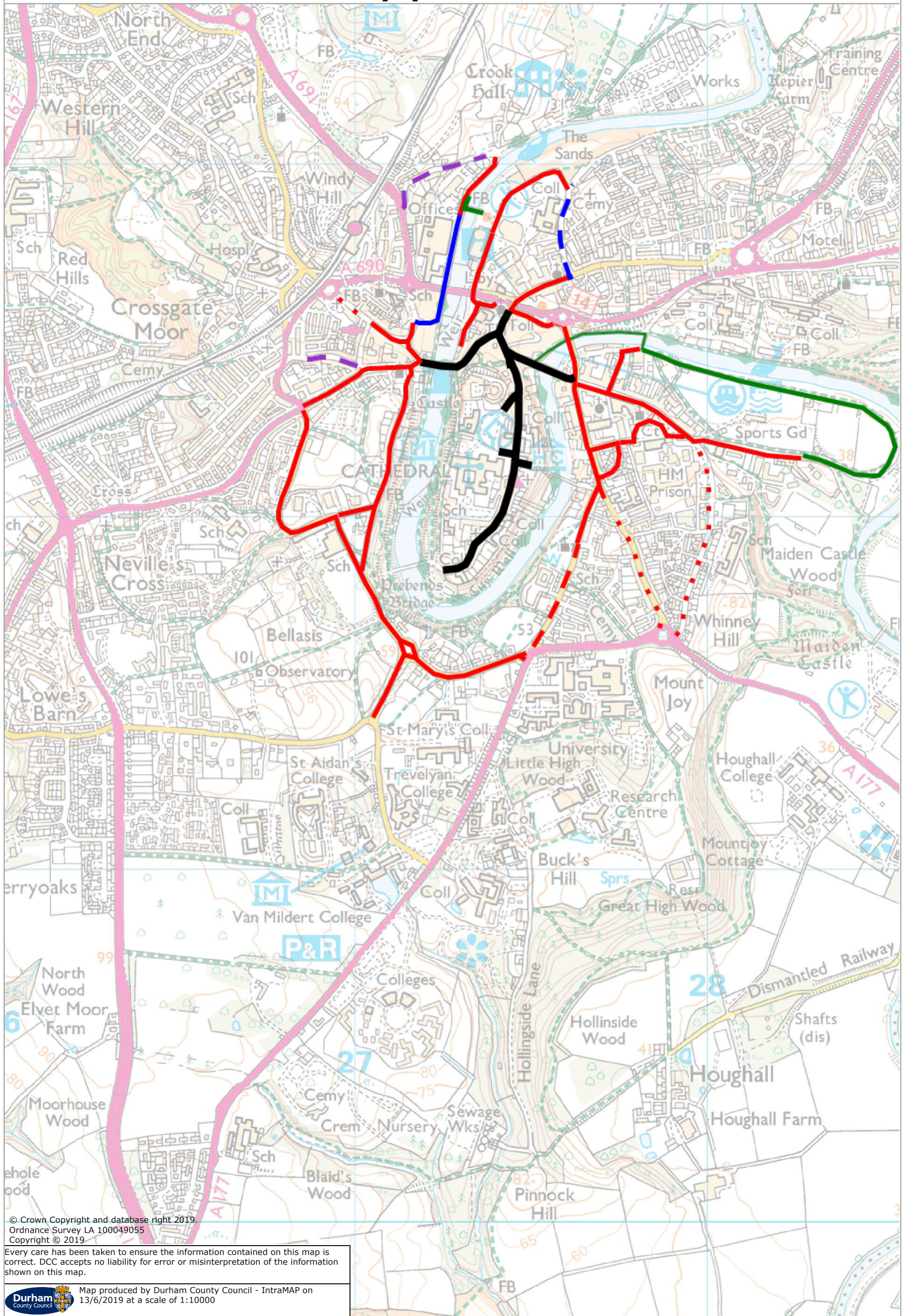
