Purpose of the Report

To consider a request for temporary traffic regulation by Order on 14/08/19 for the purpose of works following an emergency closure as a result of a safety examination.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Council exercises its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to effect a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order to facilitate the proposed works

Background

The bridge was closed under emergency and, pending Historic England consent, will be repaired in the coming months.

Options

Other traffic management arrangements have been considered and the most appropriate method is to continue the temporary closure to vehicles (with a potential for full closure if required)

Recommendation

The recommendation is approved and that following, consultations with the Chief of Police, arrangements be made to progress the advertising of Public Notices and sealing of an Order.
