Purpose of the Report

To consider a request for temporary traffic regulation by Order on 01/05/20 for the purpose of Surface Dressing works throughout County Durham.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Council exercises its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to effect a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order to facilitate the proposed works.

Background

A programme of Surface Dressing has been agreed to undertake resurfacing works within the confines of the highway in various locations throughout the county.

Options

Other traffic management arrangements have been considered and the most appropriate method is for a blanket order covering the works which are short term (typically one day or less) per location over a period of up to 5 months.

Recommendation

The recommendation is approved and that following, consultations with the Chief of Police, arrangements be made to progress the advertising of Public Notices and sealing of an Order.
