### **Purpose of the Report**

- 1 To consider changes to the Public Rights of Way network.
- 2 Public Footpath No. 80 Stanley Parish, proposed Diversion and Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order.

# **Executive summary**

- To enable development in accordance with outline planning permission granted 22 May 2020, namely the provision of up to 60 residential dwellings at Barcusclose Lane, Burnopfield, it is necessary to divert Public Footpath No. 80 StanleyParish.
- 4 Consultations on the proposed diversion have been carried out and no objections have been received.

#### Recommendation

- The proposal is in accordance with the Council's policy and the statutory framework on the diversion of public rights of way.
- It is RECOMMENDED that a Diversion and Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order be made under the provisions of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 to divert Public Footpath No. 80 Stanley Parish to enable development to proceed in accordance with planning permission, and the Order shall subsequently be either confirmed or referred to the Secretary of State for determination, and that the Corporate Director of

Resources be informed accordingly, as per paragraph 70 of the Constitution of the County Council.

## **Background**

- An application has been received from Avant Homes to divert Public Footpath No. 800 Stanley to enable the development of up to 80 residential units plus associated works at Burnopfield, as shown on the attached plan.
- 8 Outline planning permission was granted on 22 May 2020 and an application for reserved matters was submitted on 28 September 2020.
- 9 Footpath No. 80 runs in a generally south-westerly direction from Barcusclose Lane across the development site to join FP 79 Stanley and will therefore be affected by the proposed development. To enable the development to proceed in accordance with planning permission it is therefore necessary to divert Public Footpath No. 80.
- The proposal is to divert Footpath No. 80 onto a slightly more easterly route, within the large area of proposed public open spacem maintaining the link through to Footpath No. 79.
- 11 Consultations have been carried out with the Local Members, the Cabinet Portfolio Holder, the Ramblers' Association and other user groups. No objections have been received.

## **Options**

This is the minimum diversion possible to enable the development to proceed. The proposal retains and protects public access at this location.

#### Conclusion

13 Agreed to the Diversion Order in accordance with the Recommendation.


