Purpose of the Report

To agree to the sealing of a Deed of Covenant that accompanies the ERDF Grant Funding Agreement for the Low Carbon Depot project.

Executive summary

- 2 CMT agreed in August 2019 to submit an ERDF outline application for the Low Carbon Depot project.
- In January 2020, DCC were invited to submit a Full Application. CMT agreed to the submission of the ERDF Full Application in August 2020 for a total of £5m.
- On the 8th January 2021, we received an in-principle approval for the ERDF from MHCLG, subject to the execution of the funding agreement.
- The Grant Funding Agreement was received on the 28th January 2021 and was sealed by the County Council on the 5th February 2021 (593543).
- MHCLG have advised that a Deed of Covenant is a requirement to accompany the ERDF offer letter. Following this, we will need to register this deed with the land registry. Neither action is contrary to what we were expecting with regard to ERDF terms and conditions in relation to retention of assets.
