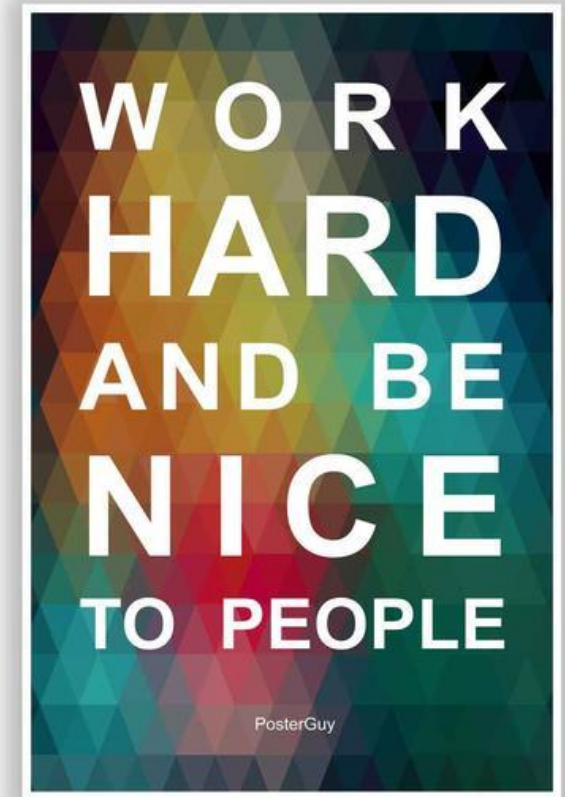
Ensure that all Pathway Plans have a clear overall objective and timely measurable actions

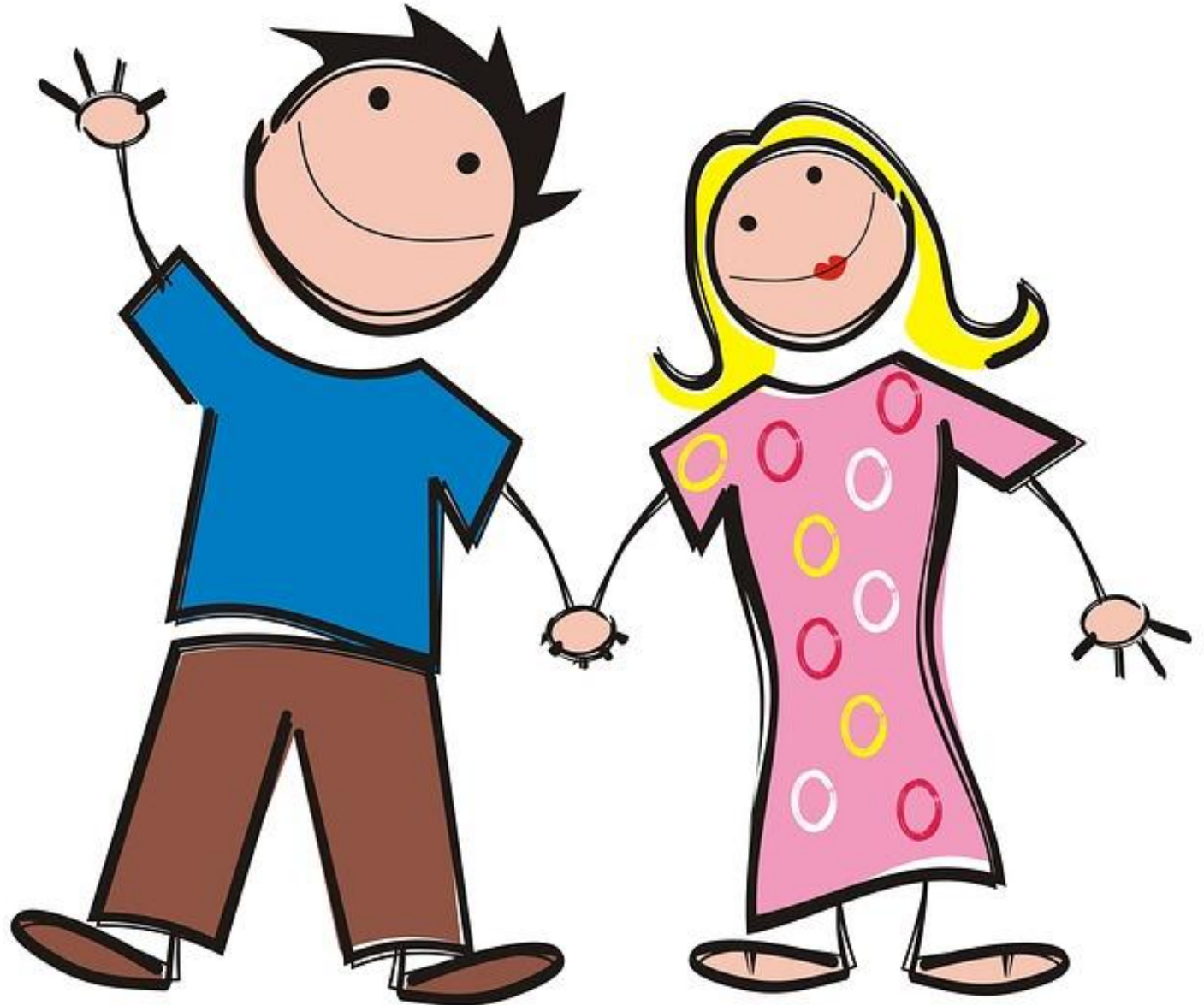
