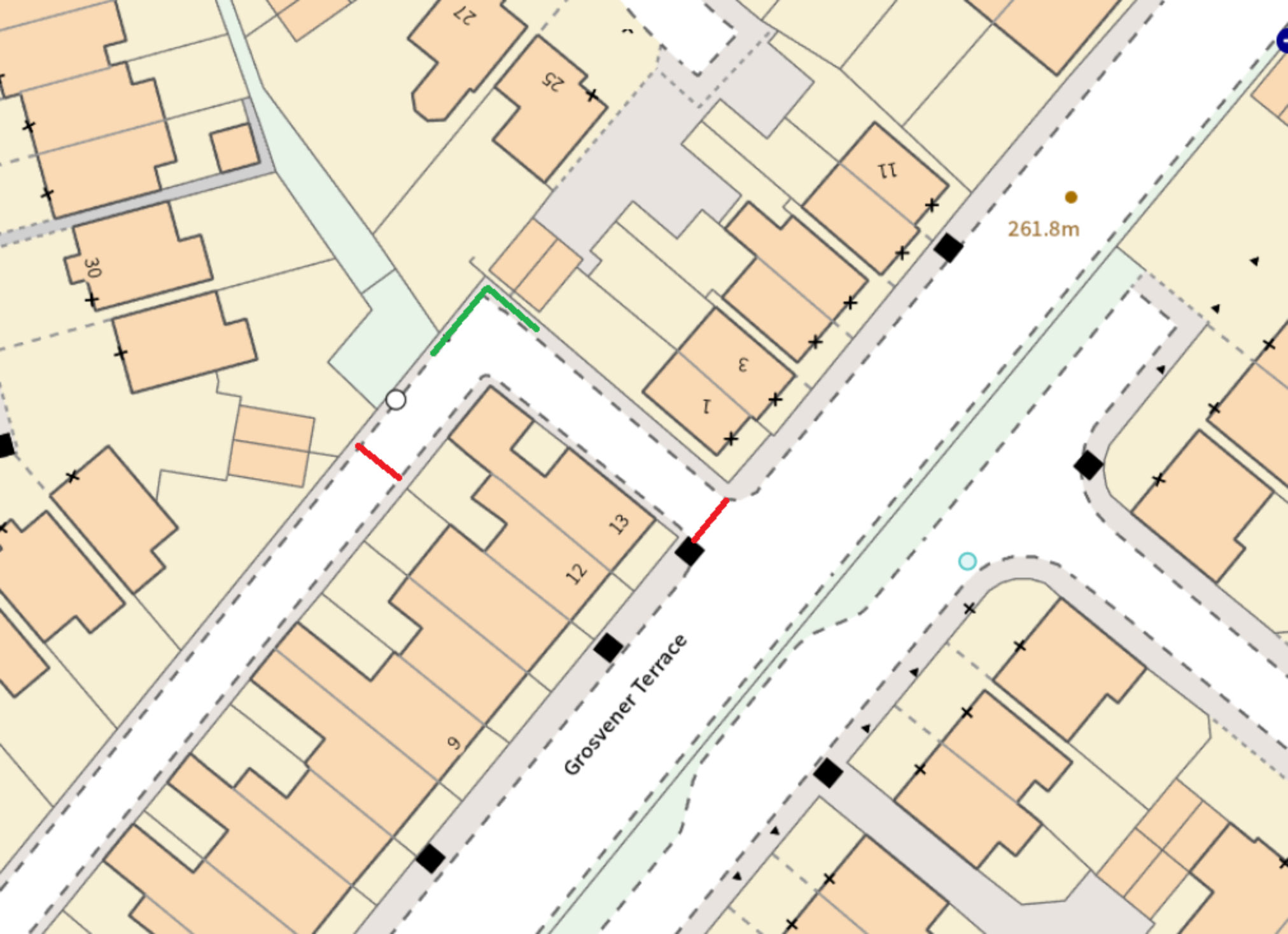

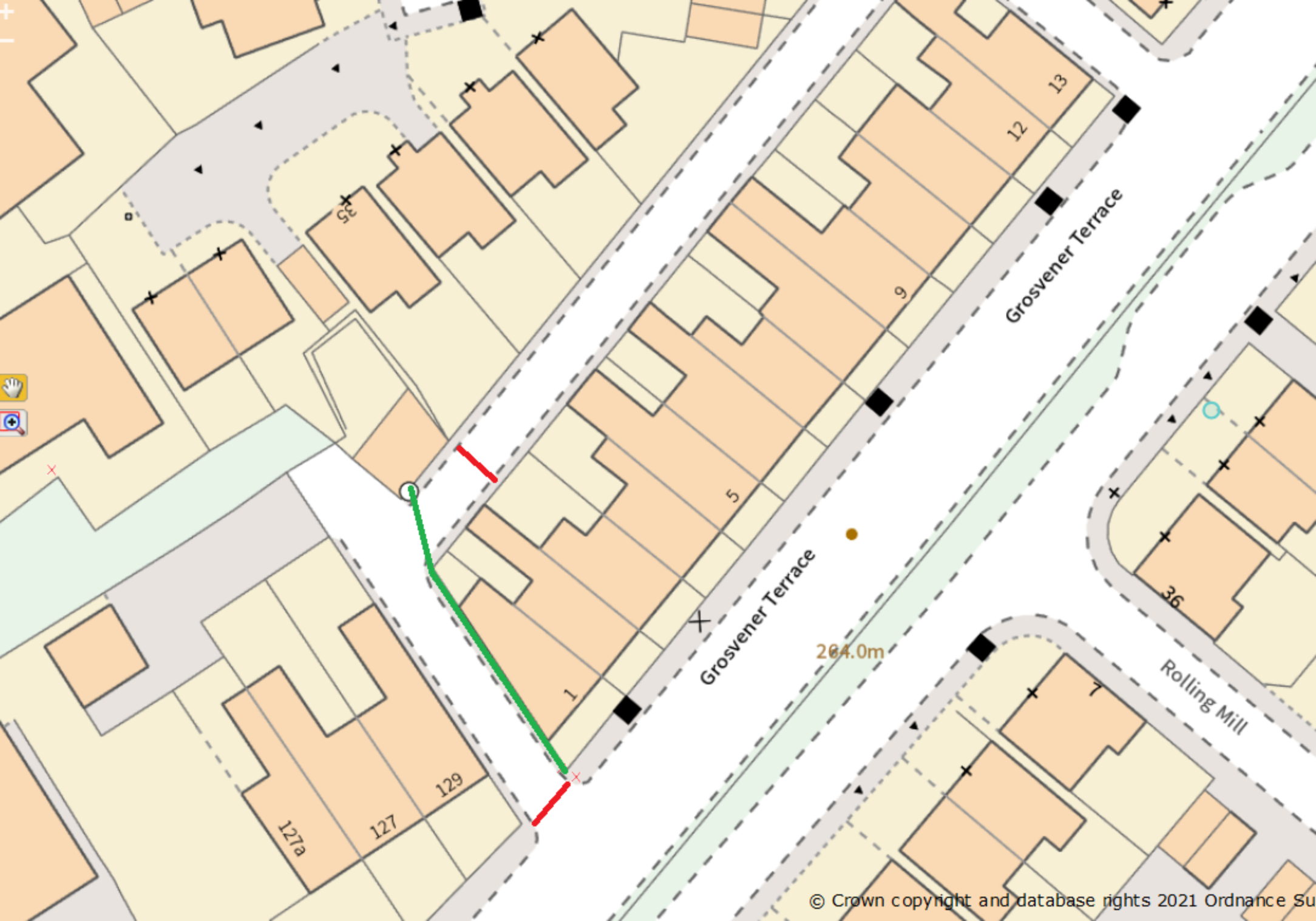

Grosvenor Terrace, Consett Temporary Road Closure Order

The Corporate Director of Neighbourhoods & Climate Change and the Ward Members have authorised the above closure. In exercise of that authority I have agreed to a request for the closure to vehicular traffic of a 40 metre length of side number 1 to rear number 3; and a 37 metre length of side number 13 to rear number 12 Grosvenor Terrace, Consett.

The closure is necessary to enable the telecom cable duct works to be carried out and is required from 8.00 am on Monday 14 February 2022 and for the duration of the works anticipated to be 5 days in total (between the two phases).

An alternative route will be available to vehicular traffic via front Grosvenor Terrace and the alternative access to rear Grosvenor Terrace, and vice versa.

I shall be obliged if on my behalf you will now proceed with the advertising and making of an appropriate Order under the provisions of Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 necessary to effect the temporary closure.

To enable telecom cable duct works to be undertaken, it will be necessary to temporarily close to vehicular traffic a 40 metre length of side number 1 to rear number 3; and a 37 metre length of side number 13 to rear number 12 Grosvenor Terrace, Consett.

The closure will be effected by an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended). The Order will be effective from 8.00 am on Monday 14 February 2022. The anticipated duration of the closure is 5 days in total but will be phased with closures be undertaken independently.




