Purpose of the Report

To consider a request for temporary traffic regulation by Order on 7 February 2022 for the purpose of new house build works adjacent to Footpath Number 97 Dene Valley Parish, East Deanery, South Church.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Council exercises its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to effect a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order to facilitate the completion of the proposed works

Background

Works are proposed by the landowner (Mr Harrop) to undertake new house build works within the confines of the highway.

Options

Other traffic management arrangements have been considered and the most appropriate method is for temporary public footpath closure from 7 February 2022 for a period of around 12 weeks.

The recommendation is approved and that following, consultations with the Chief of Police, arrangements be made to progress the advertising of Public Notices and sealing of an Order.
