1 Apologies for Absence

Apologies for absence were received from Councillor L Mavin.

2 Substitutes

There were no substitute Members.

3 Minutes

The minutes of the meeting held on 17 November 2021 were confirmed as a correct record and signed by the Chair.

4 Declarations of Interest

Councillor D Stoker declared that he had sat on the previous hearing for the application to be determined today.

6 Consideration of the Ongoing Suitability of a Hackney Carriage Driver

The Chair welcomed the Licence Holder and his Partner to the meeting and introductions were made.

The Sub-Committee considered the report of the Corporate Director of Neighbourhoods and Climate Change to determine the ongoing suitability of the Licence Holder to continue to be licenced as a Hackney Carriage Driver (for copy of report, see file of minutes).

The Licensing Enforcement Officer was in attendance and presented the report correcting an inaccuracy at paragraph 5, the correct date being 18 November 2021. The Council's Solicitor and the Licence Holder were given the opportunity to ask questions of the Licensing Enforcement Officer.
