Purpose of the Report

To consider a request for temporary traffic regulation by Order on Saturday 9 July 2022 for the purpose of preventing obstruction of the highway during the Chilton annual Miners Banner Parade.

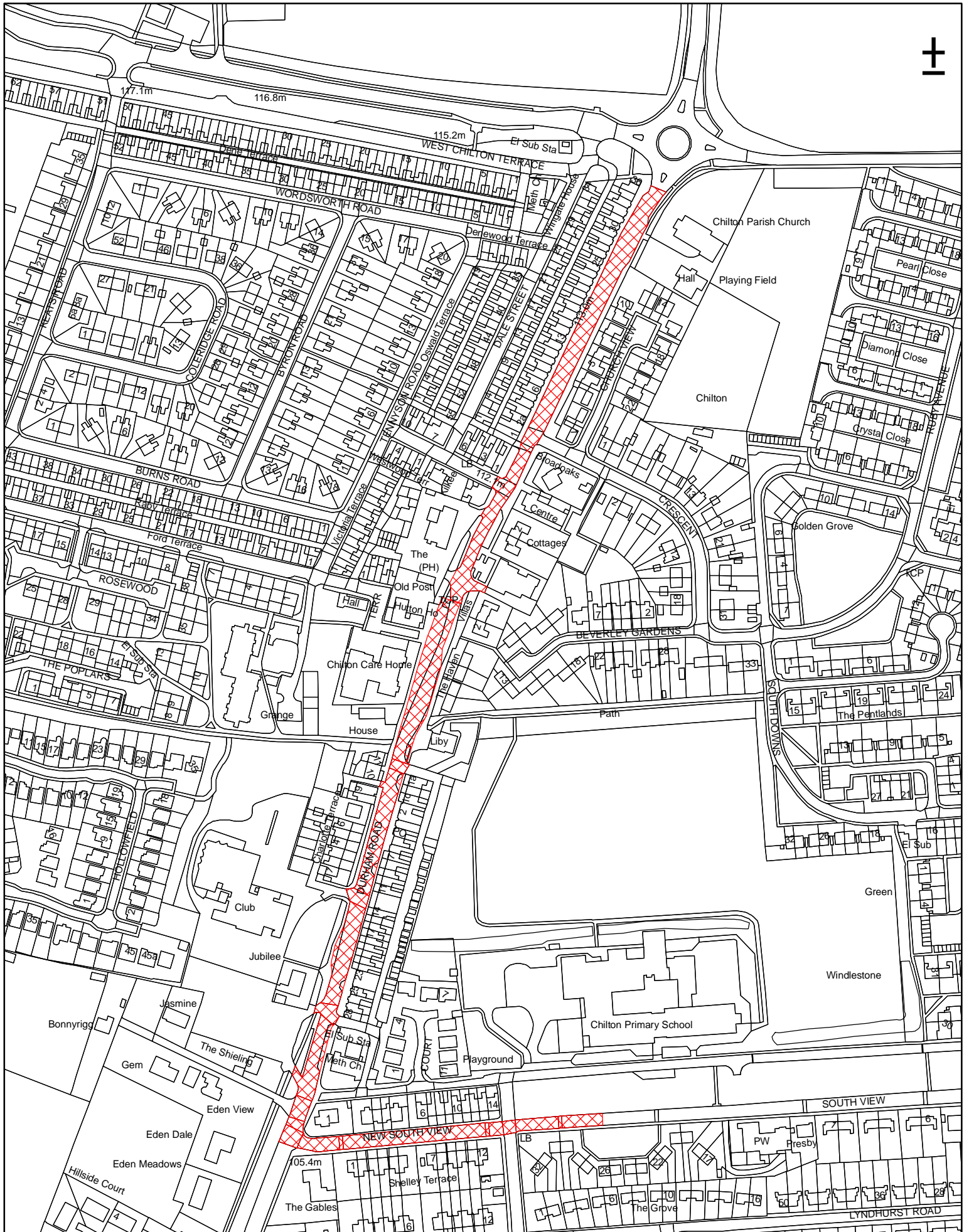
