Purpose of the Report

To consider a request for temporary traffic regulation by Order on Saturday 2 July 2022 for the purpose of preventing obstruction of the highway owing to the holding of a children's street party on rear Taylor Avenue, Bearpark (nos 113-121).

Background

Works are proposed by a resident (Ms E Taylor) to undertake a children's street party (bouncy castle) event within the confines of the highway.

Other traffic management arrangements have been considered and the most appropriate method is for temporary closure of the end of cul-de-sac for 1 day.
