## 5 **Consideration of the Ongoing Suitability of a Hackney Carriage Driver**

The Sub-Committee considered the report of the Corporate Director of Neighbourhoods and Climate Change to determine the ongoing suitability of the Licence Holder to continue to be licensed as a Hackney Carriage Driver.

A representative from Durham Constabulary was in attendance and confirmed the information held on their records. There were no questions of the Officer.

**Resolved:** That the Licence Holder's Hackney Carriage Driver Licence be suspended for one month and a 12-month written warning be issued for the vehicle licenses.
