following correspondence with Colette Longbottom I comment as follows.

I object to the stopping up of any public rights of way which are part of the "application land" in respect of the application for a village green at Belle Vue which is subject to Judicial Review. My understanding is that the Judicial Review has been triggered by the possibility of an "error in law" in the decision making process. I consider it unwise or improper, therefore, to stop up any rights on the land whilst the potential rights of the public on that land are within the legal process.
