Purpose of the Report

To consider a request for temporary traffic regulation by Order on Monday 16 October 2023 for the purpose of footway widening and street lighting works on Spring Road Aycliffe Industrial Estate.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Council exercises its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to effect a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order to facilitate the proposed works

Background

Works are proposed by DCC to undertake footway widening and street lighting works within the confines of the highway as part of the Stockton-Darlington railway walk improvement scheme.

Options

Other traffic management arrangements have been considered and the most appropriate method is for temporary 7.5 t weight limit on Spring Road, north of Heighington Lane Roundabout for approx. 3 weeks.

Recommendation

The recommendation is approved and that following, consultations with the Chief of Police, arrangements be made to progress the advertising of Public Notices and sealing of an Order.
