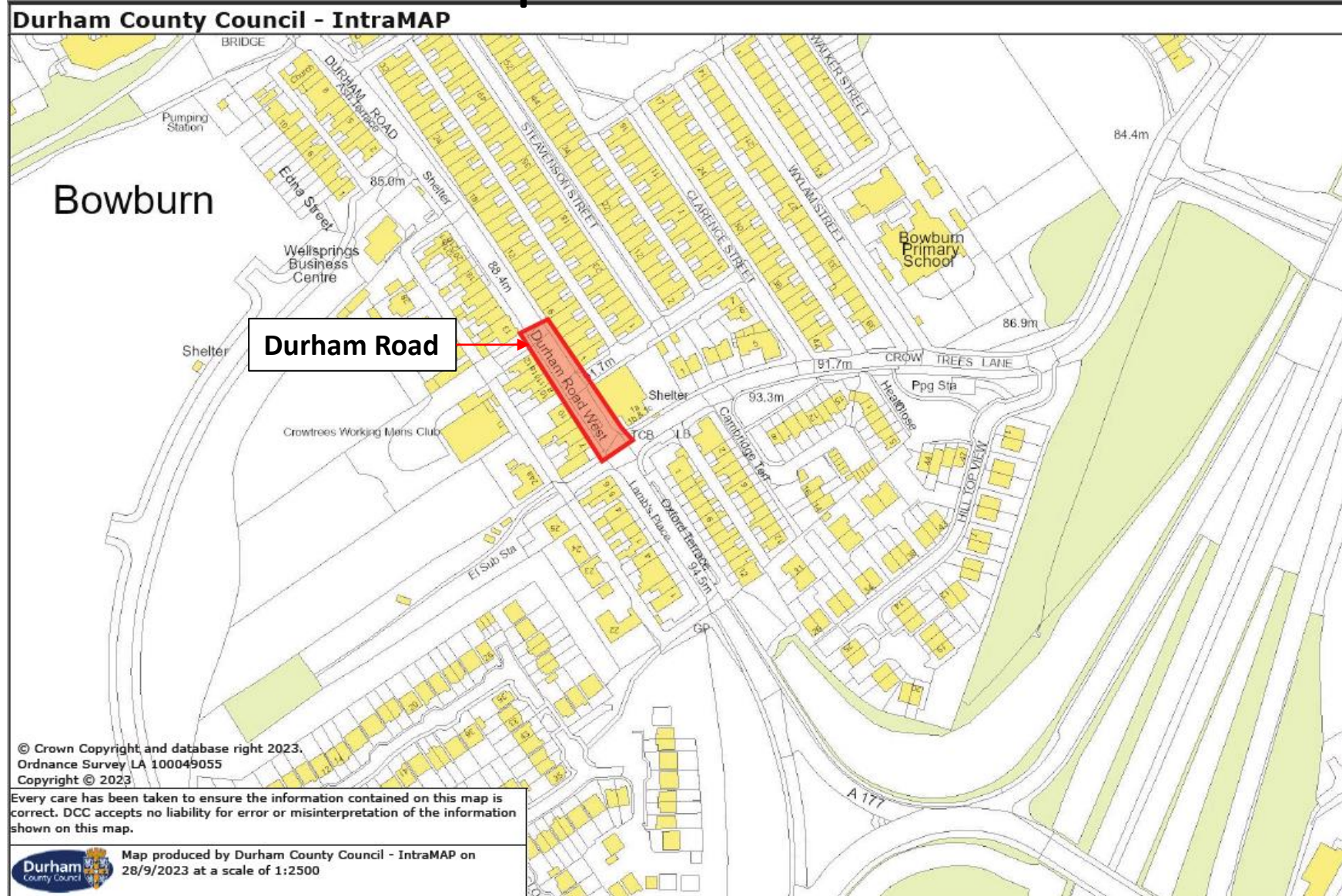

HGV's Obstruct traffic flow around the pedestrian island when loading from Durham Road.

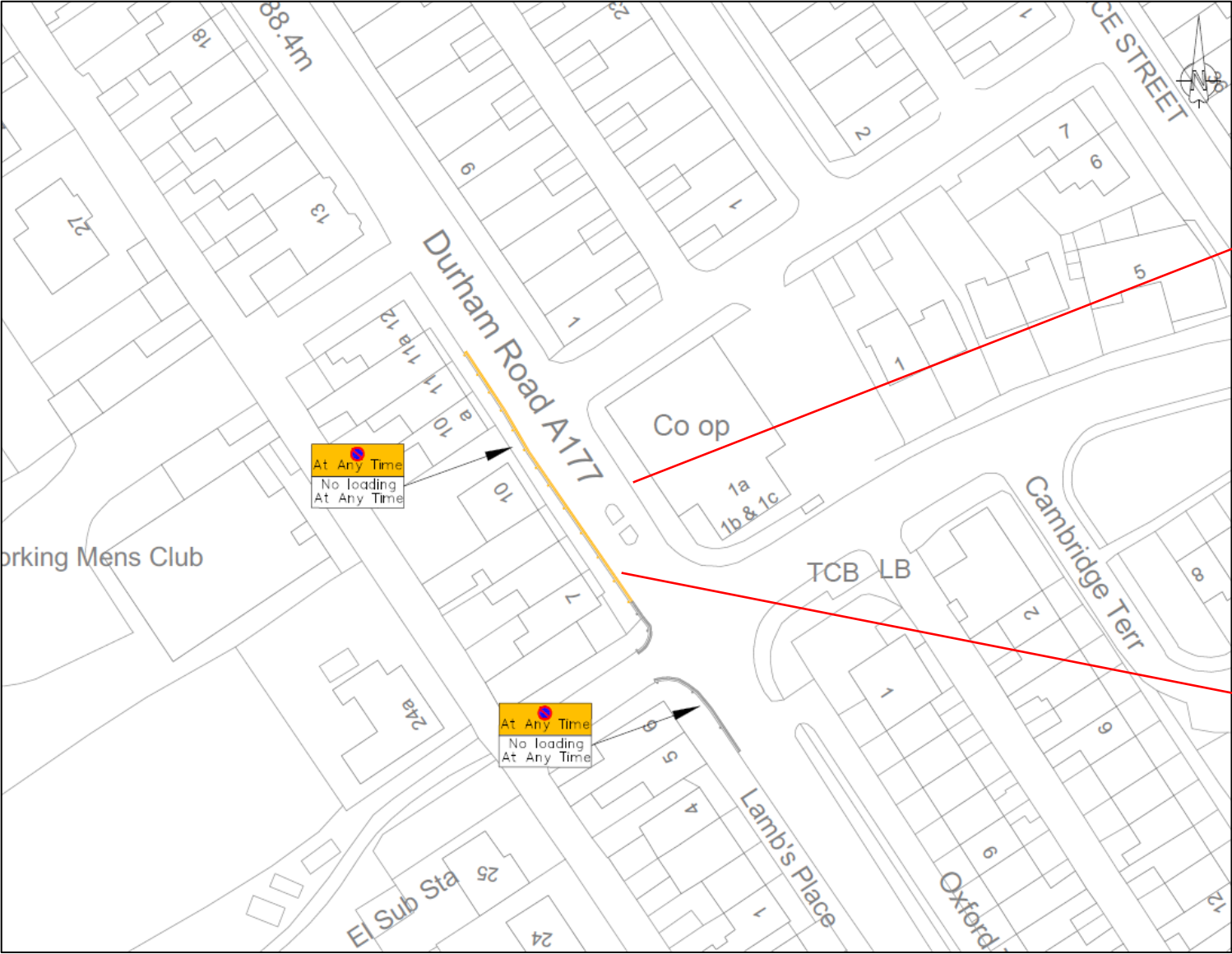

Durham Road – Proposals Locations

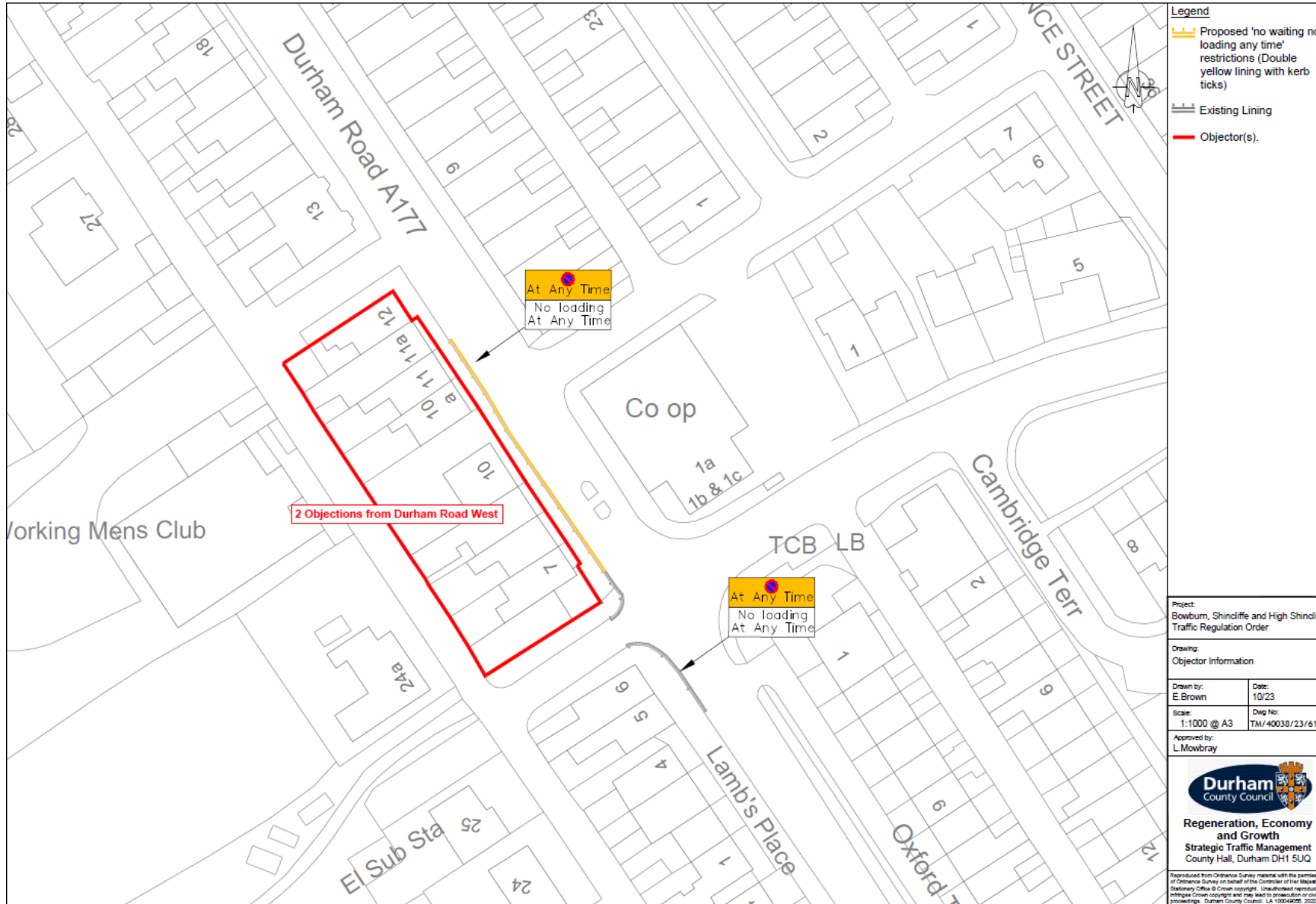


Bollards previously introduced on north-eastern side to prevent obstructive parking, loading/unloading.

Durham County Council - Summary

Durham Road – The proposed restrictions have been requested to address obstruction issues associated with loading/unloading from Durham Road. They will also improve visibility for all road users approaching the pedestrian crossing in this location.
