Purpose of the Report

To request approval to progress a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) to introduce 2x Prohibition of Right Turn Orders and 1x Prohibition of Entry Order on the A691, Framwellgate Peth, Durham.

Executive summary

DCC have requested the introduction of 2x Prohibition of Right Turn Orders and 1x Prohibition of Entry Order as part of The Gardens Development at Milburngate on the A691, Framwellgate Peth, Durham.

Recommendation

To approve the progression of the TRO as requested.

Background

Durham:

A691, Framwellgate Peth is located northwest of Durham. The area predominately consists of residential properties as well as being a bus route. The A691 is the main link road between Durham & Consett and provides a high-volume route for road users between both locations.

As part of the ongoing Milburngate development in Durham, 2x Prohibition of Right Turn Orders are required to prevent any vehicular

traffic turning right on the A691, Framwellgate Peth into the junction to The Gardens, Milburngate and The Gardens, Milburngate westbound into the A691, Framwellgate Peth. 1x Prohibition of Entry is also required to prevent any vehicular traffic from entering The Gardens left turn exit from the A691, Framwellgate Peth, Durham.

Main implications

Conclusion

It is recommended to progress to formal advertising of the TRO subject to satisfactory consultation, proceed to seal and the creation of an enforceable TRO.

From time-to-time consolidation of orders may be required following amendment of an Order. If this is considered necessary, then this Authority may be used for the advertising and sealing of the Orders.

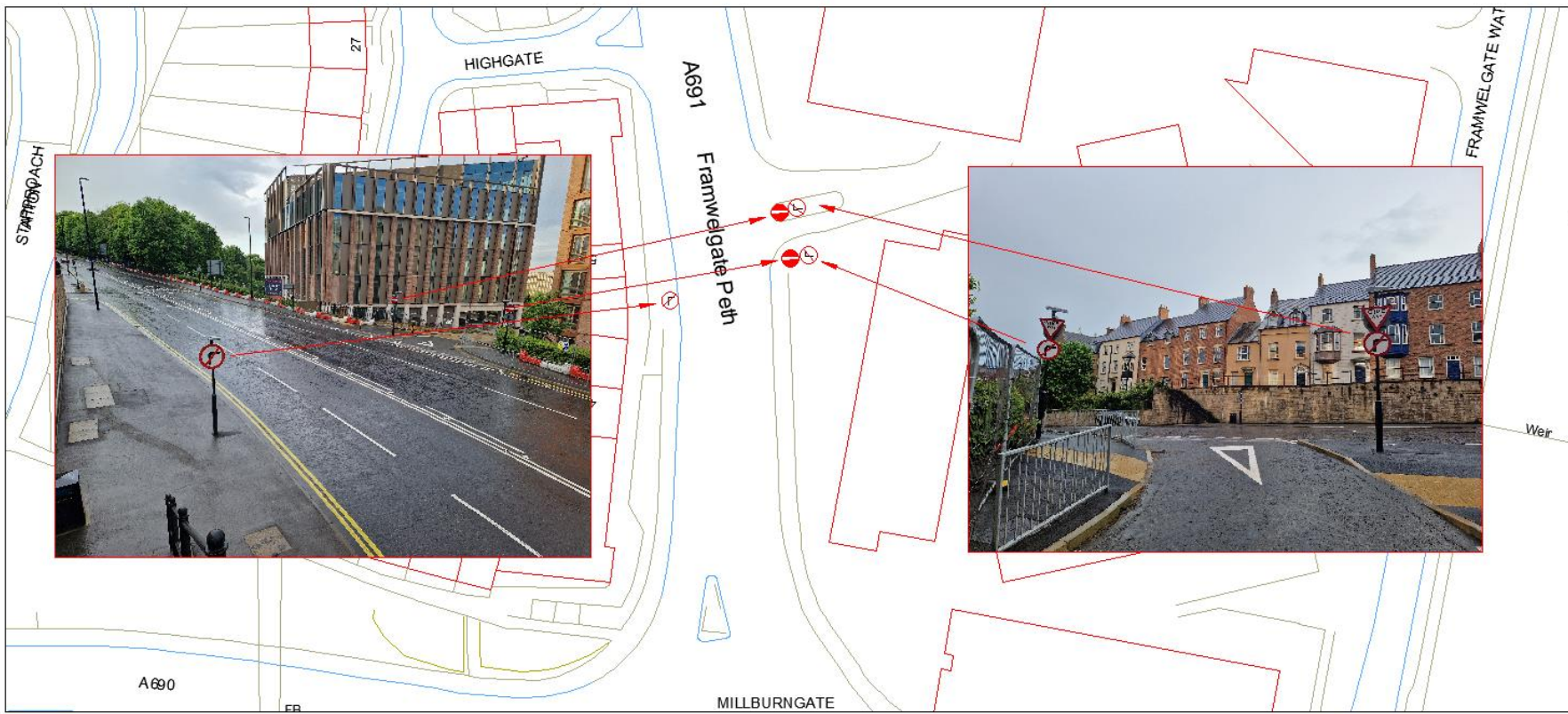
