Purpose of the Report

To request approval to progress an Experimental Traffic Regulation Order (ETRO) to introduce parking and waiting restrictions on Victoria Road in Consett.

Executive summary

Requests have been received via the local Member of Parliament from local hackney carriage drivers regarding the lack of taxi provision within Consett town centre. It is therefore recommended to make an ETRO.

The proposals will see; the introduction of a 'no stopping except taxis, Monday – Sunday, 6pm – 8am' restriction within the existing limited waiting bay (Monday – Saturday, 8am – 6pm, 1 hour no return).

It is anticipated that these amendments will improve road safety by providing hackney carriages with a safe place to stop and collect passengers.

Recommendation

To approve the progression of the TRO as requested.

Background

Durham County Council have received a request to investigate the suitability of a taxi rank in the Front Street area of Consett. Front Street is located within Consett's commercial town centre – home to a number of bars and restaurants as well as the Empire Theatre & Cinema.

Senior Members of Durham County Council's Traffic Section met with the local MP and representatives from the taxis to discuss the potential introduction of a 'taxi rank'.

It was agreed that provision would be sought on Victoria Road – a lightly trafficked area compared to Front Street and on the same side of the carriageway as the majority of the amenities in the area, reducing the need for pedestrians to cross Front Street, thus improving road safety.

These proposals have received a neutral response from Durham Constabulary, asking that we progress as an ETRO to allow for the local area to be monitored before making a decision on whether or not the restrictions are made permanent.

Victoria Road, Consett
