Purpose of the Report

To consider a request for temporary traffic regulation by Order on Sunday 24 November 2024 for the purpose of preventing obstruction of the highway during the Durham City Christmas Lights Switch on event affecting Market Place, Saddler Street, Silver Street and Elvet & Framwellgate Bridges.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Council exercises its powers under the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 to effect a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order to facilitate the proposed event.

The Durham City Christmas Light Switch-on event is proposed by Durham BID / AH Events within the confines of the highway.

Other traffic management arrangements have been considered and the most appropriate method is for temporary road closure between the hours of 5.00 and 6.30 pm

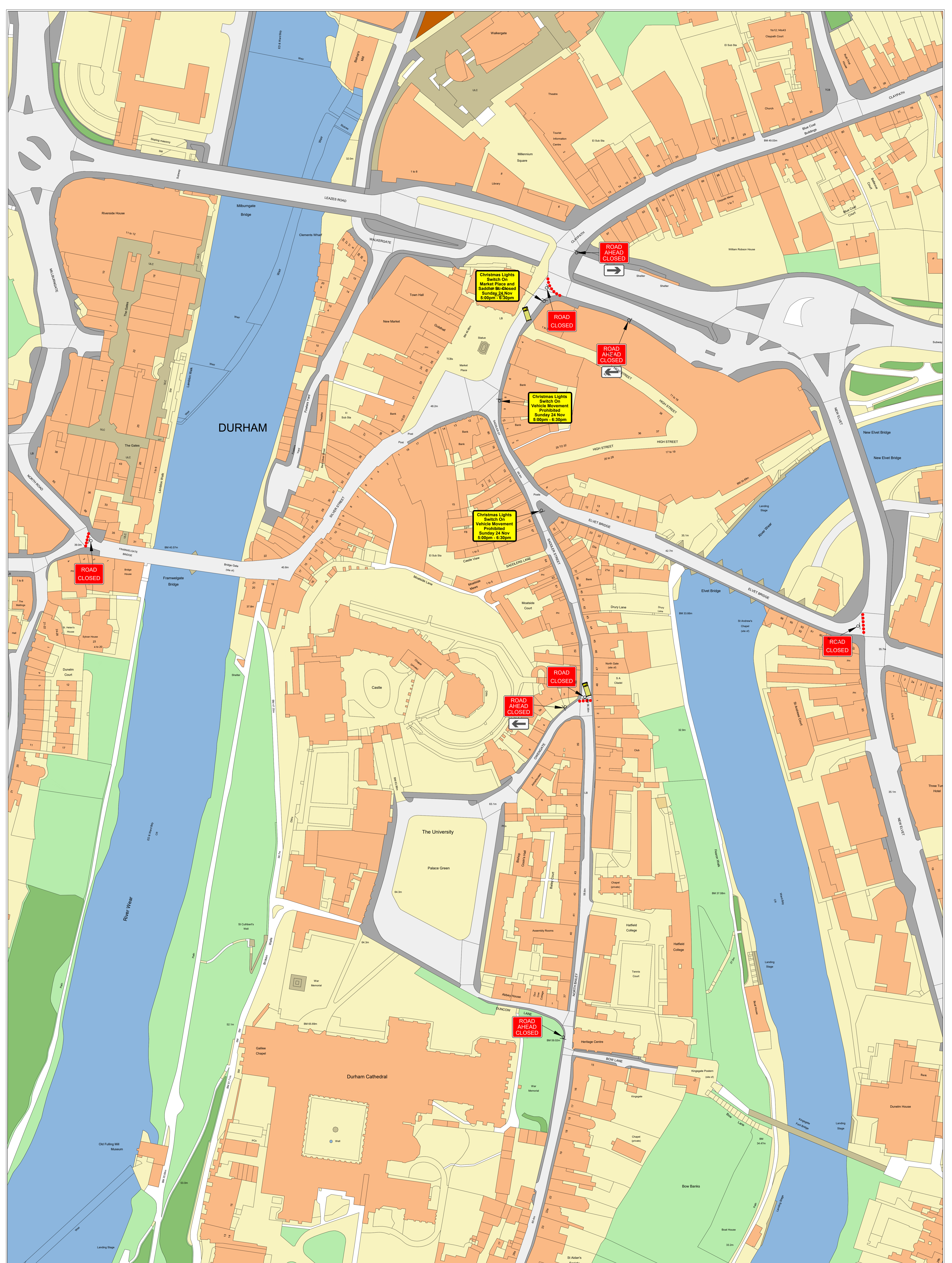
