### **Purpose of the Report**

To consider a request for temporary traffic regulation by Order on 8 November 2024 for the purpose of safeguarding pedestrians following a land slip on or adjacent to Footpath 13 Urpeth Parish off Hammer Square Bank, Beamish.

### **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the Council exercises its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to effect a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order to facilitate the safety measure until the route is safe to re-open

### **Background**

A land slip on Footpath 13 Urpeth Parish has rendered the route unsafe for pedestrians.

### **Options**

Other traffic management arrangements have been considered and the most appropriate method is for temporary public footpath closure for up to 6 months or until the path is safe to re-open whichever is the sooner.

### **Recommendation**

The recommendation is approved and that following, consultations with the Chief of Police, arrangements be made to progress the advertising of Public Notices and sealing of an Order.
