### **Purpose of the Report**

- 1 To consider changes to the Public Rights of Way network.
- 2 Public Footpaths Nos. 30 and 32 Evenwood & Barony, proposed Diversion and Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order.

## **Executive summary**

- In the interests of the landowner it is proposed to divert part of Public Footpath No. 30 and all of No. 32 Evenwood & Barony Parish.
- 4 Consultations on the proposed diversion have been carried out and no objections have been received.

#### Recommendation

- The proposal is in accordance with the Council's policy and the statutory framework on the diversion of public rights of way.
- It is RECOMMENDED that a Diversion and Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order be made under the provisions of the Highways Act 1980 and the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 to divert Public footpaths Nos. 30 and 32 Evenwood and Barony Parish in the interests of the landowner, and the Order shall subsequently be either confirmed or referred to the Secretary of State for determination, and that the Corporate Director of Resources be informed accordingly.

## **Background**

- An application has been received from the landowner, Mr Stewart of East Park Farm, to divert part of Public Footpath No. 30 Evenwood & Barony to move the footpath away from the domestic property in the interests of security and privacy, and to divert Public Footpath No. 32 to a straight-line route from one field corner to the other in the interest of agricultural efficiency, as shown on the attached plan. The owner of the land crossed by the new route has provided his agreement.
- Footpath No. 30 runs in a generally northerly direction adjacent to the buildings at East Park Farm, while Footpath No. 32 runs in a generally east-north easterly direction, on a curved route across the field immediately east of the farm buildings.
- 9 The proposal is to divert a section of Footpath No. 30 onto a more easterly alignment, along the western edge of a field, and to divert No.32 to a straight route running diagonally north-westerly from field corner to field corner.
- 10 Consultations have been carried out with the Local Members, the Cabinet Portfolio Holder, Evenwood and Barony Parish Council, the Ramblers' Association and other user groups. No objections have been received.

## **Options**

11 The proposal retains and protects public access at this location.

#### Conclusion

12 Agreed to the Diversion Order in accordance with the Recommendation.
