IRO Annual Report for children in our care

Overview

- As of 31st March 2024, there were 1213 children in the care of DCC
- Equates to 122 per 10,000 children above the National Average of 70 and slightly below our regional comparators of 113.4
- Timeliness of our CIC reviews has remained high at 96% (2800/2916)
- Children's participation in their reviews continues to be a strength with only 2% of children not contributing to their meeting
- Timeliness of Foster Care Reviews is excellent with 95% of Foster Carers having a review within a year.

IRO Scrutiny/Impact

- Ensure children have a plan of permanence and a stable, permanent home without delay
- Ensure care planning is robust and is meeting children's needs
- Ensure IRO oversight of our most vulnerable young people in care
- Resolution Process is used to have challenging but effective conversations with the Local Authority that make a difference for children and shape practice
- IRO statements to court at Final Hearing is very much embedded
