Providing guidance to the Corporate Director, Neighbourhood Services and the Corporate Director, Regeneration and Economic Development as appropriate, in relation to the exercise of delegated functions under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, where objections have been made and not withdrawn. <li data-bbox="762 786 1453 999">3. Providing guidance to the Corporate Director Regeneration and Economic Development as appropriate, in relation to the exercise of delegated functions under sections 4, 5, 6 and 7 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1953 where objections or representations are made and not withdrawn. <li data-bbox="762 1021 1453 1167">4. Any other non-executive functions specified in the 2000 Regulations relating to highways or public rights of way which require a statutory notice or consultation and where objections have been made and not withdrawn. <li data-bbox="762 1223 1453 1312">5. To discharge the Council's licensing, registration and regulatory functions in relation to common land and town and village greens.
