Purpose of the Report

The purpose of this report is to provide members with an introduction to a presentation given by Jeff Garfoot, Head of Corporate Finance, on changes to Durham County Council's banking provider.

Background

- In November 2013, the Co-operative Bank announced its intention to withdraw from the Local Government market.
- Although the authority has a contract with the Co-operative Bank until 2016, it is now necessary to appoint a new banking supplier. There are 130 other local authorities in a similar position.

Next steps

- A project plan has been developed which focusses upon the initial procurement phase moving then onto the transition phase as service switches between the old and new bank.
- It is expected the new provider will be appointed by the end of 2014, with the new bank become active from October 2015.
- Once final arrangements are in place, all Council staff will be updated with details of the new bank.
