- 3 HECA requires all local authorities in England to produce a biennial progress report on the measures they have taken to achieve this aim.
- BEIS has set a deadline of 31st March 2017 for Local Authorities to publish their biennial HECA progress report setting out their objectives to improve the energy efficiency of homes in their locality and the actions taken to help achieve these objectives.
